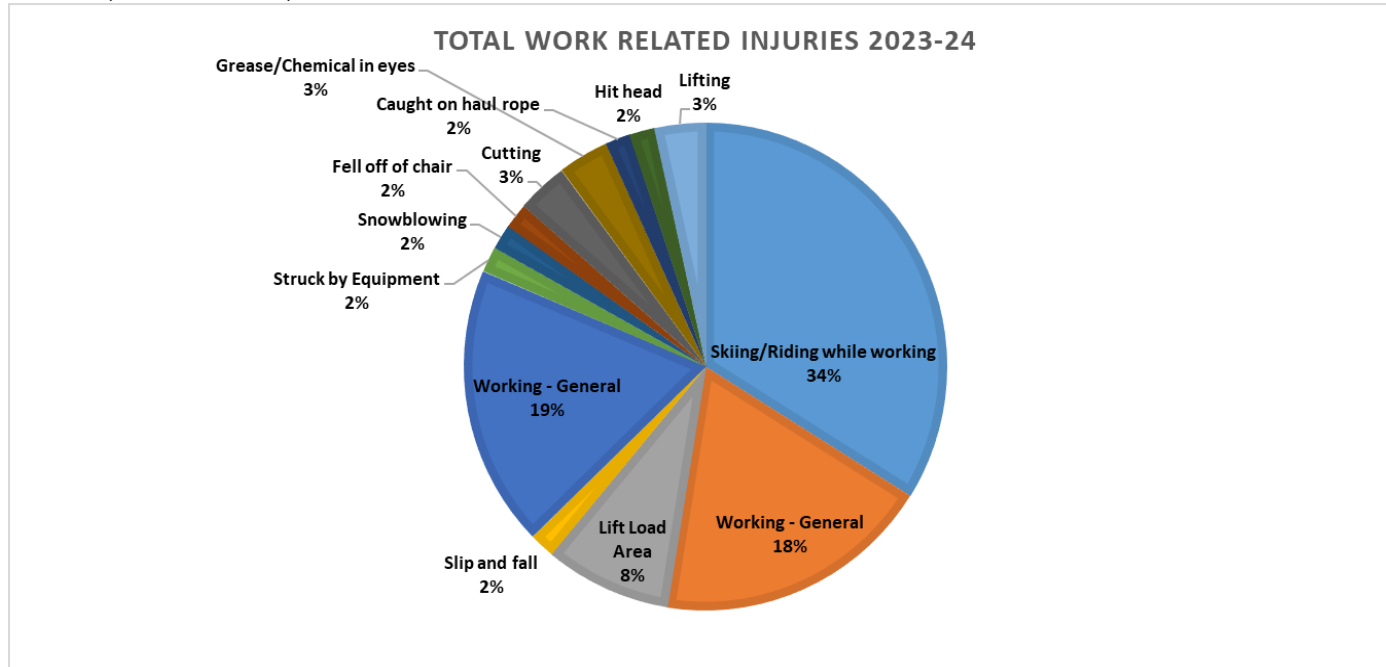
The area below keeps track of all incidents on the mountain so Whitewater understands hazards, trends, and where improvements can be made.
